

Sound Insulation Testing Checklist

The following points should be followed closely to avoid unnecessary re-tests. Contact UK Sound Testing in the first instance on 01234834870 with any queries. 24 hours notice of difficulties on site is normally required to avoid incurring fees for aborted tests. UK Sound Testing reserves the right to charge additional fees for extended time on site if the site conditions below are not met.

- Unobstructed access to rooms both sides of partitions to be tested
- All partitions to be tested should be complete e.g. skirting boards should be fitted, electrical sockets installed in walls etc
- Room and front doors should be in place and closable
- Windows should be in place and closable
- Carpets or timber laminates should NOT be laid above floors that are to be tested
- A 110V or 240V power supply is required within 25m of the partitions to be tested. Please let us know if 110V power is required
- Other site operatives should be made aware that sound insulation testing will be carried out prior to the site visit. Other operatives should be instructed to avoid rooms in which the sound testing equipment is placed *
- It is possible to carry out the sound tests around some intermittent site noise, however relatively quiet site conditions are required
- Parking on or near the site

*NOTE: This is especially important for 110V sites as the sound testing equipment runs on 240V power. The 110V site power will be converted to 240V by a transformer positioned adjacent to the sound testing equipment. Please note that the transformer requires a Class 1 construction power source.
